



CORB LUND GOES FOR THE GOLD ANNOUNCING PERFORMANCES AT 2010 WINTER OLYMPIC GAMES

NEW TOUR DATES INCLUDE A RUN OF US WEST COAST SHOWS
IN SUPPORT OF NEW WEST RECORDS DEBUT ALBUM
LOSIN' LATELY GAMBLER

#1 Most Added Album At Americana Radio

October 14, 2009 (Los Angeles, CA) - Acclaimed Juno-Award winning singer/songwriter Corb Lund announces new tour dates, including appearances at the 2010 Winter Olympic Games and in the Western US with stops in Seattle (11/15), Portland (11/16), San Francisco (11/18) and Los Angeles (11/19). The tour is in support of his first New West Records release *Losin' Lately Gambler*, which debuted at #20 on the Canadian Soundscan chart. According to the [Houston Press](#), "Lund and *Losin' Lately Gambler* present us with a new and meaningful 21st century addition to the traditions of Western and cowboy music, something to succeed the likes of Ian Tyson and Ramblin' Jack Elliott and save their art from total extinction." Showcasing what [The National Post](#) in Canada calls "...a robust mix of country, western and rock..." *Losin' Lately Gambler* was recorded in Nashville and produced by Harry Stinson.

The record is the #1 most added album at Americana radio this week debuting at #33 on the Americana Music Chart. *Losin' Lately Gambler* continues to garner additional attention at influential stations such as KHYI in Dallas, KNBT in San Antonio, WMNF in Tampa, KEXP in Seattle, KPFT in Houston and WFPK in Louisville. The video for "A Game In Town Like This," which [CountryChart.com](#) calls "a country western masterpiece," has been added at CMT TV in Canada.

Lund sells out arenas in Western Canada and is becoming increasingly visible in the United States. He's toured solo, as well as with other artists, including Robert Earl Keen and Hayes Carll – who joined Lund onstage recently in Austin. Lund's music reaches across genres allowing him to appear at varied major festivals worldwide from the main stage at Glastonbury in the UK, the Americana Music Association festival in Nashville and Virginfest in Canada.

Being born and raised in rural Southern Alberta, Lund would likely have had a more traditional country sound, but went through a musical development in his teens, as a founding member (and key writer) of a successful indie rock band called The Smalls. He has been singing about his upbringing, in his own style, for more than a decade on critically acclaimed albums such as the Canadian gold-selling *Five Dollar Bill* (2002), *Hair In My Eyes Like A Highland Steer* (2005) and *Horse Soldier! Horse Soldier!* (2007). He has recently won the Canadian Country Music Association's Roots Artist of the Year for the sixth consecutive year. Lund has also won countless Western Canadian Music Awards, Canadian Folk Music Awards and both Canadian and U.S. Independent Music Awards.
